

A Personal Note From B.T. Farris: The Shib Burn

Is there more to the burn than simply reducing circulation?

There's a lot of awareness that needs to be brought to cryptocurrency and the understanding of what crypto can do for our future; how it can create a more free society without greed, without middle men and without other factors that shouldn't be involved in this space to begin with.

We believe that greed, not currency, is the root of all evil. When certain people became empowered and were able to make rules that benefited only them, the one-percenters came to be, and the gap continues to grow.

We also believe that if you don't have to use their system, then they can't profit from you, they can't benefit from you and they lose their control over you. Cryptocurrency is a way to get people into a more secured, more globally accepted form of currency. I won't go into the intricacies of blockchain and the workings of cryptocurrencies at this time. We'll leave that to the professionals who will be sharing their expertise at the Now Then event on April 29th through May 1st.

Farris' Freak'n 50th Birthday Burn... A lot of people might think that it has something to do with Burning Man because of my involvement with the Burning Man group since 2010. Though, there will be an effigy built to be burned, but that's not what this burn is about. This is about the burning of Shiba Inu coins to create a smaller amount available for all of the coin holders to benefit from.

A "burn" is whenever you send a cryptocurrency to what's called a dead wallet, where it can't be recirculated back into the network. Our goal is to not only benefit the Shiba Inu community with the burn, but to also present a media stunt that will attract attention and awareness to crypto as a whole.

We are selling our general admission tickets, one day GA passes and three day GA passes, where half of the proceeds from those tickets sold will go to buy Shiba Inu to put into a wallet for a public burn at the event. The general admission price for both the one-day and three-day passes will be deducted out of the VIP passes and half of those ticket prices will also be sent to purchase Shiba Inu for the burn Saturday night, live on the main stage.

We are in negotiations now with a top headliner act that will have a great draw around the north Texas area...and nationally. Our local opening act, Dartanyan Kane, will help get things started.

We'll have the burn between Dartanyan Kane and the headliner on April 30th. There will also be tickets being sold for our live streaming event where 100% of those net profits will go to purchase Shiba Inu for the burn as well.

It is our objective to burn a billion Shiba Inu at once, in a fun, educational and informative public format. We are not connected with Shiba Inu in any form other than being holders of the coin and understanding the value of reducing the overall amount in circulation for the community at large.

We are in conversations with specific people who are within the Shiba Inu community, the "Shib Army" and Shiba Inu influencers, to come and talk on the influencer stage so that the information can get out directly from the people who are stewarding the ship, or Shib I should say. ;)
